

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-3

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2006-32 OF THE CITY OF GREENSBURG, INDIANA CODE OF ORDINANCES, KNOWN AS THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION ORDINANCE, TO ESTABLISH A DOWNTOWN COMMERCIAL HISTORIC DISTRICT

Downtown Greensburg Historic District

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Greensburg, Indiana, by passage of Ordinance Number 2006-32 has created Section 4 of the Municipal Code of the City entitled “Historic Districts, Conservation Districts and Guidelines;” and

WHEREAS, Sections 4.A through 4.F provide procedures by which areas may be designated as “Historic Districts;” and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2006-32 needs to be amended to reflect the designation of the area bounded roughly by:

Beginning at the intersection of North Street and the alley located west of Broadway; thence south along the alley to Railroad Street; thence east along Railroad Street to the west side of East Street; thence north along East Street to the intersection of East Street and the alley located north of Main Street; thence west along the alley to the alley east of and running parallel to Franklin Street; thence north along the alley to North Street; thence west along North Street to the point of beginning.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENSBURG, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. The properties bounded roughly by Beginning at the intersection of North Street and the alley located west of Broadway; thence south along the alley to Railroad Street; thence east along Railroad Street to the west side of East Street; thence north along East Street to the intersection of East Street and the alley located north of Main Street; thence west along the alley to the alley east of and running parallel to Franklin Street; thence north along the alley to North Street; thence west along North Street to the point of beginning, are hereby designated a Historic District, and in the regard Ordinance Number 2006-32 is hereby amended thereof the designations herein made.

SECTION 2. The map submitted herewith as Exhibit A is approved and it is noted that all legal steps have been taken by the Historic Preservation Commission pursuant to Sections 4.A through 4.F of Ordinance 2006-32 Municipal Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any and all necessary approval by the Mayor. This ordinance is hereby Adopted and Approved by the Common Council of the City of Greensburg this _____ day of _____, 2011.
