Call to Order –President Bill Ernstes called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Roll call - Board members present were: Bill Ernstes, Jon Dooley, Jim Pruett, Don Whipple, and Oris Reese (Arr: 7:07 p.m.). Airport Manager Jerry Scheidler, Paul Shaffer of BF&S and Mayor Dan Manus were also present. Judy Curd performed the duties of Secretary.

Agenda Approval – The meeting agenda was reviewed. Jim Pruett made a motion and Don Whipple seconded the motion to approve the agenda as presented. The motion passed unanimously by Voice Vote 4-0.

Minutes – Judy Curd read the April 23, 2018 minutes. Don Whipple made a motion and Jim Pruett seconded the motion to approve the minutes as read. The motion passed unanimously by Voice Vote 4-0.

Financial Report – Jon Dooley read the Financial Report.

OLD BUSINESS

Possible New Hangar – Jon Dooley reported that he had been in touch with prospective hangar renters, Paul Freeland and Chad Miles of ETC to discuss their commitment to rent a new hangar and other issues concerning the hangar construction. Jon has set a meeting with Paul Freeland and Chad Miles for Thursday, May 31.

Current hangar renter, Don Bowling spoke to the board about his concerns if a new corporate-style hangar were to be erected at the end of dead-end taxiway. Issues listed by Mr. Bowling were: 1) Surface water removal, 2) Snow removal, and 3) General congestion. He added that the board may want to consider building the new hangar at another location on the airport property or continuing the current taxiway around the hangars to allow planes to exit the hangar area at either end.

Q/T AV Fuel – Jerry Scheidler stated that we have received notice from Q/T AV Fuel that they are going to discontinue service and parts support for our existing card reader system due to lack of parts availability. After discussion, the board asked Jerry to get a quote from Q/T AV and from Fuel Master, another card reader supplier.

NEW BUSINESS

Paul Shaffer of BF&S – Paul reported that he had received a call from Bob of the FAA stating that they are still waiting to hear from FAA headquarters for a response. Paul also noted that AIA is sponsoring the INDOT Pavement Preservation Workshop to be held at the Indianapolis International Airport on June 6, 8:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Admission is free.

Airport Manager’s Report – Jerry Scheidler reported existing hangars are still full.

Approval of Bills – Bill Ernstes presented the bills for approval. Oris Reese made a motion and Jim Pruett seconded the motion to approve the payment of bills as listed. The motion passed unanimously by Roll Call Vote 5-0.

Comments from the Board and/or Public – Bill reported that he and Paul Shaffer met with representatives from Lowes’ Pellets and Grain to address their concerns.

Meeting Adjournment & Next Meeting Date –There being no further business before the board, Oris Reese made a motion and Don Whipple seconded the motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion passed unanimously by Voice Vote 5-0, and President Bill Ernstes adjourned the meeting at 7:29 p.m. The next meeting will be held on Monday, June 25, 2018, at City Hall at 7:00 p.m.
